4. Networking and relationship building within community



REGISTER LOGIN

Learn to Love to Read is back in schools providing one-to-one support to children who are finding learning to read difficult. We are also continuing to support children online via zoom.

School closures as a result of COVID have been particularly hard for children who normally require extra help with their learning, children who come from more disadvantaged families with few home resources to support learning and children who have limited access to WiFi and digital devices.

We ask our volunteers to commit to 90 minutes a week, one afternoon a week, usually between 1-3pm. Volunteers support the same three children each week, providing 20 minutes of one to one support.

If you are keen to volunteer virtually, please get in touch as well to see if we have any current opportunities.

All applicants are required to complete an application form, provide references, undertake a short interview and attend training, including safeguarding. All volunteers must have an enhanced DBS check (we arrange this on behalf of our volunteers). Once you have registered, you will be sent a link to the application form.

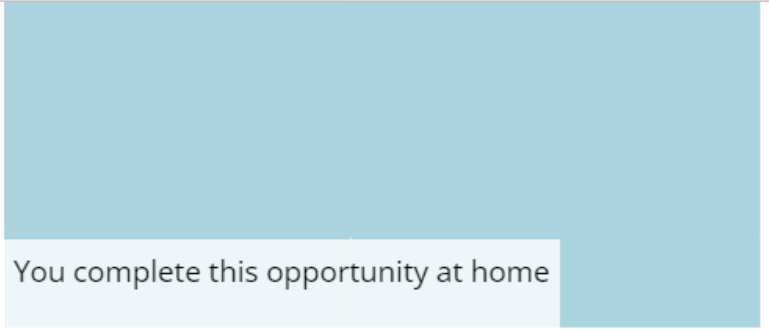

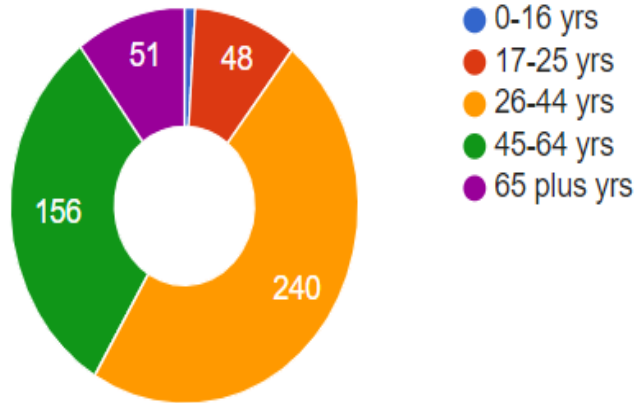

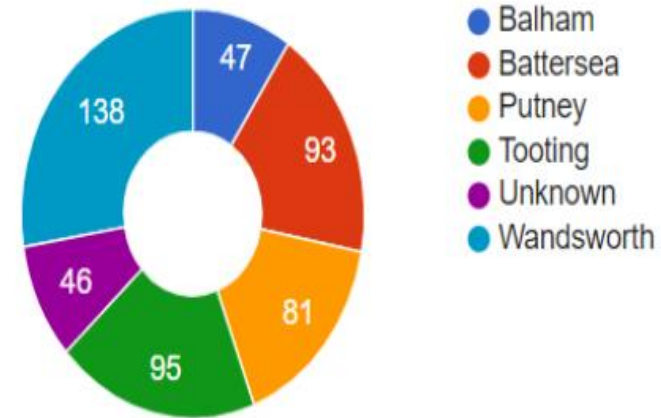
Age Groups (average age 42) ?

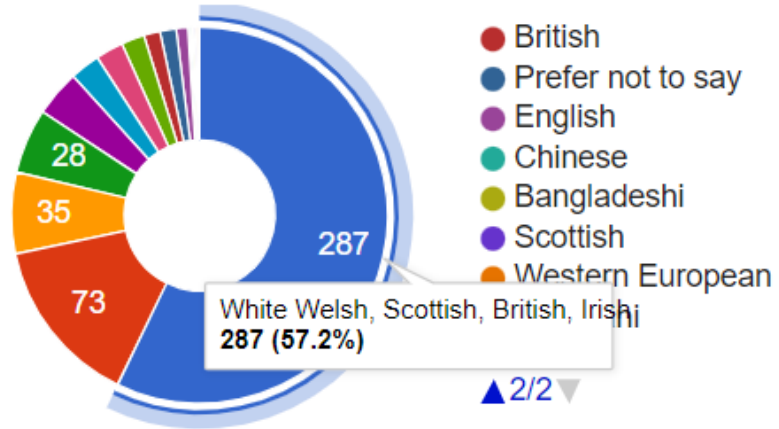

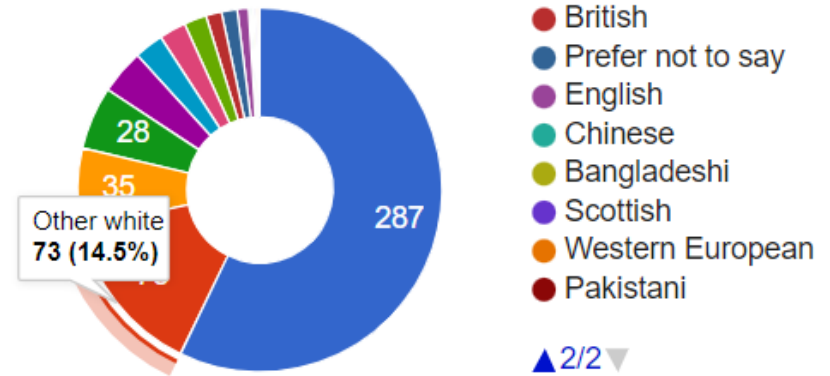

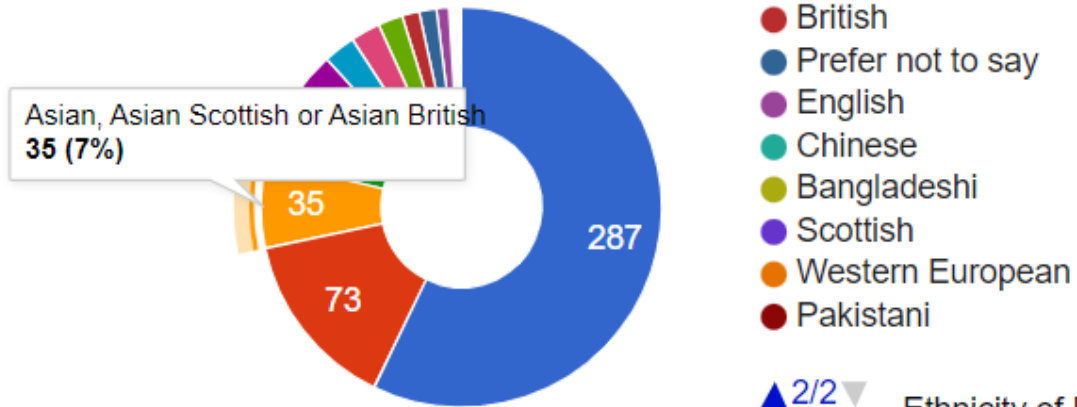

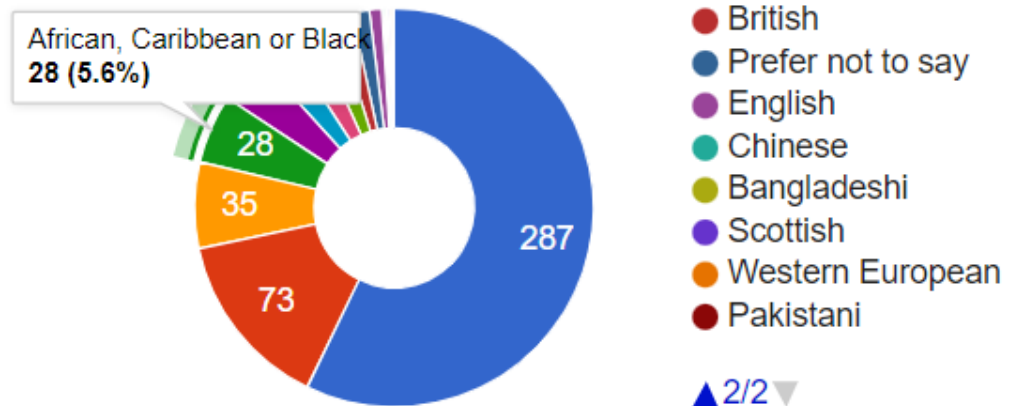
